A HUDSON VALLEY WINE AND SPIRITS GUIDE

Hudson, NY is a well known hub for antiques surrounded by farmlands, apple orchards and beautiful hiking trails. But there's been a slow transformation that's attracting global attention. Hudson now boasts of gourmet restaurants, the best nightlife north of New York City, a progressive cultural scene and artists community that's giving the city its own unique feel.

Renovations across the city have revamped colonial and early industrial age buildings into top recording studios, galleries, and spas. While the city itself is racing through a renaissance, the surrounding hills have also been feeling what's happening in Hudson. Beautiful country roads are now also home to vineyards and artisan distilleries.



While the Napa Valley has been the long standing American Viticultural area, there is now a complex web of stellar grape growing regions across the country.
Local flavors and artisan specialties are giving rise to a new type of wine culture.
In Columbia County, passionate vineyard owners are producing their wines using techniques and philosophies deeply rooted in the history of the Valley and the idiosyncrasies of the land. The widespread use of older, more focused techniques for making wine have contributed to the region's reputation as a producer of exquisite single batch flavors that are on par with the best the world has to offer.

Regulatory measures that kept New York distilleries in check since prohibition have recently been softening to attract more business to the state. The Hudson Valley has benefited from this new deal for distilleries because it's the best region in the state for excellent locally sourced crops. Craft distilleries in Columbia County are now creating some of the best whiskeys available in the world, using tried and tested techniques that use local fruits and grains. Below is a selection of some of the region's best known and delicious wineries and distilleries.

Hudson-Chatham Winery, Ghent, NY

Perhaps the winery that exemplifies the Hudson Valley style the most. This Winery is truly a labor of love that utilizes vintage techniques and grapes perfectly paired to the land. In a beautiful pastoral setting between Hudson and Chatham, this winery is a must-see. It's the highest ranked winery in the Capital Region.

Millbrook Vineyard & Winery, Millbrook, NY

Serving both exquisite wine and gourmet fare, has been been ranked by local critics as the best winery in the Hudson Valley for 18 years. In addition to local recognition, the New York Times has called Millbrook: "The Hudson Valley's Flagship Winery". Situated a half hour south of Hudson, Millbrook consists of 130 acres, thirty of which are used in wine cultivation. The vineyard mainly cultivates Chardonnay and Cabernet Franc, with Pinot Noir, Tocai Friulano and Riesling as well.

Oak Summit Vineyard, Millbrook, NY

Oak Summit vineyard spreads across 6 acres of fertile Hudson Valley soil in which perfectly paired grapes grow into some of the most intense flavors found in the Hudson Valley. This vineyard has won gold on multiple occasions at the World Wine Championships, winning as recently as 2009. The quality of the wine here is propelled by the high levels of expertise evident in the detailed analysis of the soil and attention to Ancient Roman wine philosophy displayed on their website.

The Hillrock Estate Distillery is run by a former master distiller of the Maker's Mark brand of whiskey. Hillrock Estate is situated on acreage dominated by a colonial era house in which the distillery itself lies. Their connection to the roots of the valley run deep, exemplified in the use of their own grain raised up from their rich fields, and their attention to tradition of distilling that seemed to have long since departed from New York.
